

Almondbury Community School - Uniform Support

In order to support well managed transitions to your new school we are committed to offering financial support in relation to the provision of uniform items which contain school branding.

With this in mind, our advice is that you do not purchase any branded uniform items for the school your child will be attending from September 2020.

We understand, of course, that children will grow out of generic items of uniform such as shirts, blouses, trousers, skirts and shoes. As your child will be moving to a different school, you may wish to take that school's uniform policy into account when replacing these generic items – for example, the kind of shoes which are acceptable.
